**527-7 RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE STRATEGIC ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN -APPROVED**

WHEREAS, the Three-Star Program was developed to meet the needs and challenges of the evolving economic environment in urban and rural communities and to partner with communities to create opportunities for sustained economic growth; and

WHEREAS, communities seeking certification as a Three-Star community must meet certain criteria, including the adoption of a five-year strategic economic development plan; and

WHEREAS, in achieving the mission of the Three-Star Program, the Department of Economic and Community Development commits to assist communities in developing and implementing a strategic economic plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the county legislative body of Monroe County, Tennessee, meeting in regular session at Madisonville, Tennessee, that:

SECTION 1. The legislative body of Monroe County declares that the county has adopted a five-year strategic economic development plan to be updated annually.

SECTION 2. The strategic economic development plan includes the county's economic goals in promoting economic growth, a plan to accomplish those goals and a projected timeline in achieving those goals.

SECTION 3. The strategic economic development plan addresses the county's goals pertaining to existing industry, manufacturing recruitment, workforce development, retail/service, tourism, agriculture, infrastructure assessment and educational assessment.

**527-8 RESOLUTION: TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM GENERAL PURPOSE SCHOOL FUNDS TO FEDERAL PROJECTS FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30 2010-APPROVED**

WHEREAS. Federal Projects grants operate on a reimbursement basis and funds are requested from the State of Tennessee by *Monroe County School District* for non-payroll expenditures on a monthly basis; and.

WHEREAS. the Federal Projects Fund operates with a cash deficit at various times throughout the fiscal year due to a slow turn-around time for reimbursements from the State of Tennessee; and,

WHEREAS. Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) consider a cash deficit in any fund to be a significant deficiency in internal control; and.

WHEREAS. *Monroe County School District* does not desire to operate any fund with a cash deficit.

NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of *Monroe County School District*, a school district in Tennessee, meeting in regular session on this 13<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2010, and by the County Commission of *Monroe County*, a county in Tennessee, meeting in regular session on this 27<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2010, that:

SECTION 1. The General Purpose School Fund shall transfer \$100,000.00 (not to exceed) to the Federal Projects Fund on June 30,2010.

SECTION 2. The \$100,000.00 transfer shall remain in the Federal Projects Fund as a designated fund balance from the General Purpose School Fund and may be repaid at any time as noted in a resolution passed by the Board of Education and County Commission.

SECTION 3. This resolution will take effect on June 30, 2010. The Secretary of the Board of Education shall include this Resolution in the minutes of the *Monroe County School District*. The County Clerk shall include this Resolution in the minutes of *Monroe County*.
